Dear Brethren,
I greet you all in the name of the Almighty God. I wish to thank you all for your continuous prayers and support. I wish to share with you that, this year, 2017 begun with the drought challenge which caused severe shortages in our feeding program. Omega farm did not manage to provide us enough harvest. We are currently buying food from nearby stores to support the program and the prices of food have gone high. Many thanks go to every one that has given extra donations to cater food for all the kids. We do seek your continuous prayers and God's presence.

Omega Modern Day and boarding Primary School was started by Rev Fred Tumwebaze in 2002 under a Mango Tree with 54 children. It was started in response to the overwhelming need for education services in Buwenge community, an area badly hit by HIV/AIDS that left behind many orphans, widows, street and needy children.

The pandemic orphaned over 2.5 Million children in Uganda and left families' devastated and staggering in abject poverty.

However, the enrollment at the school has since grown from the initial 54 to over five hundred children. Sponsors in the US are linked to children they desire to support and a monthly donation plus additional gifts to children and their families are received successfully. This covers School fees support, uniform and scholastic materials. All children at Omega School do receive hot porridge for breakfast and a hot meal at lunch time.

I wish to thank all our sponsors for the total commitment. On May 5th, 2017 we officially started our first term holiday and second term classes will resume on May 22nd, 2017.

We thank you all for your total sacrifices to enable our School activities to run smoothly. On May 5th, 2017 that is when our children received their termly assessment report and they gently walked home.
