I am called Taddeo Kiliwaidho. I am twenty three years old. I have grown up



in a family of ten people. My late parents gave birth to three of us. one girl and two boys, unfortunately, they did not live to see us grow. They both died at the time when we were all very young. I extend my sincere

gratitude to American families for the love and great support they give to us in Uganda. The love of my sponsor carried all my worries away, as I have been sponsored throughout all school levels from Primary to the University. And in August, 2018 I will be marching out of the gate of Makerere University with a Bachelors' Degree in Procurement and Supply Chain. This three-year Education degree has molded me to a very confident, focused future procurement officer.

My plight as a Ugandan Child started when my biological parents died. Our paternal Aunt fostered us at her home, <u>in Namwendwa Village, Jinja District.</u>

We did not notice the difference instantly but as we kept on growing, the demands at home moved us to get the story fully that, "we were missing our biological parents." Our foster family of Aunt Florence Night and Uncle Vicensio Ntalo were carrying the burden of caring for us and their biological children and grandchildren. The demands of a peasant family kept us noticing the parental gap. It was not their wish but the demands were overwhelming. I am moved to testify that, God has enabled Rescue African Children to create for us caring families overseas. Our established hope, love, and support manifests the heavenly power of God.

I joined Makerere University in 2015 after all my education trail from Omega School on. Currently I am doing my Internship with Jinja District in the department of Procurement. This will run for a short time and they will evaluate my work ability and report to my lecturers. I will also attain a recommendation to my future employer. I have moved one step at a time and I believe with the help of Rescue African Children and my family in America, I will get to the top of the ladder. I seek your constant prayers. You have sown a seed and I believe and trust that, 'it is rewarding to help somebody move from one level, one status to another."
