On the back of this Newsletter, please find your 2017 Charitable Giving Statement.

And, allow me to thank you all for the kindness you have shown your Ugandan children and pastors. I wish also to congratulate each one of you on having successfully gone through 2017. Each new year we are eager to seek the Almighty God in prayer and we also pray for you all and thank Him for all the blessings we do receive.

Before January 29, 2018 the day Omega School will be resuming serious classes, we wish to update you all that; God has answered our prayers again. In January 12, 2018 we received our Primary Leaving Examination (P.L.E) results 2017 from Uganda National Examination Board (UNEBC), and it is affirmed that we did well. In fact, within Jinja Main, we are in the eighth position. Out of the thirty six children registered at our centre, sixteen boys and twenty girls, we managed to get 19 in Division 1 (one), Fifteen in Division 2 (two) and only two in Division 3 (three). Three children emerged to be the best at our centre, one was a girl and two were boys. The good news is that, all qualify to join Senior Secondary Schools.

We need more of your prayers to God for more children this year, 2018, to pass in Division 1. We always work hard to make our children excel academically. We also need more of your prayers for good performance, good health and good supplies for Omega School. I wish to inform you that good performance of our school depends on some of the above.

I believe and trust that we are in position to serve these youngsters because of your total commitments and love towards them. It is our humble appeal that you keep on praying for us. And we will as well be praying for you all in Jesus' name. Amen!
