"There are many orphans in my village who do not go to school. The dream I have is when I get money, I will help educate those who can't afford it" These are the words of Rebecca Watali, an amazing young lady and one of the many children in Uganda who became the head of her household when she lost her Mother and her Father in a matter of a few months. In the midst of her grief, Rebecca took to raising and supporting her young brother Fred, and newborn twins, Regan and Patricia, at the impossibly young age of 14. Her life has been a miracle but a difficult one. She has leaned on God for strength to help her through many tough

Rebecca has never lost her compassion or let go of her dreams...She wishes to become a nurse, and as you can see and hear on Rebecca's video posted to our website, her desire is to help others when she is able. REACH's goal is to make Rebecca able. We can all help by taking care of some of her basic needs. Fred, Patricia, and Regan now have been sponsored and are attending school regularly. It is Rebecca's turn. Two American nurses, one in CA and one in ARK. have stepped up to help Rebecca realize her dreams to attend nursing school but the home is in need of significant repair and family support is placed solely on Rebecca.

Many changes have happened in the last year and a half. Here's the recap:

- January 2017 A new REACH USA Team was formed when Pastor Rodney retired from the crazy amount of administration that is required to keep this volunteer organization moving. Volunteers have come and gone since then. (Thank You Kimberly!) January 2018 - A new online database called Denari 2 began to process your pledge donations. Our apologies for the rough
- moments we have experienced as we continue to customize this program to ours and your needs.
- March May 1, 2018 A successful visit from Pastor Fred Tumwebaze to California, Nevada, and Arkansas. Almost 100 kids
- $\dot{ exttt{M}}$ arch 2018 All new sponsorship/pledges were increased to \$26 for children, \$50 for pastors. This is our first increase in 14years. We have now set this as the default donation for all new pledges but we do ask if our current sponsors would consider increasing from \$20 to \$26 per child. We are calling this voluntary. If the increase will cause a hardship, feel free to remain at the \$20 level. It is benefiting all the children of Omega School (those that attend) as it goes into a large fund so that all children receive necessary food, clothing, school supplies, and needed medical attention. Each child is cared for but those with sponsors know there is a family in the US who prays for them and cares about what happens to them. It is a great comfort to each child who is sponsored to know this. The letters to and from sponsors are a great blessing to them as well.
