

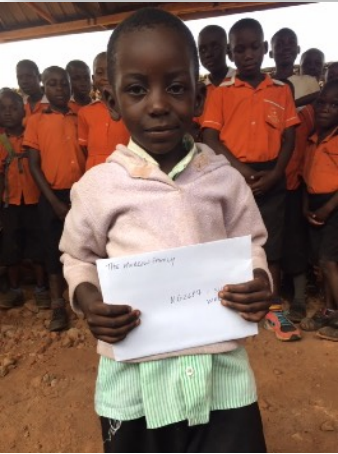

His late father, Christopher Kintu, died in 2004 in a fatal motor accident when Brian was in Primary one at Omega School. He is the seventh child in a family of a single mother called Harriet Babirye. He has five brothers and four sisters, the youngest in grade six. Brian is pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in Education (BAED) at Kampala University, Jinja Branch. He is in his first year. He joined this University in the month of May and hopes to graduate in 2023. In Brian's conversation with our Social worker, he testified that, "Rescue African Children has helped him to reach this far and he sees the future as very bright for him. He thanked his sponsors for their generous heart and continuous love." While in college he has secured a position as a classroom teacher and school Bursar in a Muslim school while he attends college.
