I wish to share with you the successful story of Shadrack Mutebi. This is a fourteen year old boy who was born with a healthy left leg, but a right leg that was twisted and lame. His biological parents were very much disturbed, especially his Father, who did not take his responsibility as expected and then later died.

Today I stand firm and pronounce Shadrack a successful boy academically. This youngster has excelled in his recent Primary Leaving Examination, 2020 He got his best grades in science and math, but English and social studies were almost just as good. He was the second in his class, just behind a young lady who took first. Omega School registered 33 candidates and (6) passed in Division 1, (26) in Division 2, and only one passed in Division three even though the year was cut short by Covid.

On August 26, 2021, our social worker visited Shadrack and his family in a village called Kawafu in Entebbe, where Shadrack and his sibling, Chris Kaima are residing with their single mother in a rented room. She survives by washing clothes for people which cannot sustain them and educate her children. Regardless, our social worker found Shadrack and the family happy. In the conversation, Shadrack was asked what he desired to do after Primary Level.

Shadrack said, "My deep desire is to join a Senior Secondary Level and my prayer request is God's provision." Again the Social worker asked him what he wanted to be in the future. Shadrack said, "If God opens up doors, I want to be a strong doctor, helping people have a good life the way I was helped by my sponsors." And in his final remarks, he sought God to be merciful to his sponsors and to continuously show them love.

God bless you all as you continue praying for Shadrack and family.
