It is a blessing to be able to share about the good things happening here at REACH Uganda. We witnessed great joy on Sunday, April 21st, as Maria finally was presented her new house. She was sponsored by a kind church in Moreno Valley, California called Movement Church. We have been building it for her for over a year.

Per Maria's words, she has been renting a small room and getting money for rent was not easy. The landlord has not been happy with her as she normally failed to meet the deadline for payment. Maria is blessed with three children all of them now attending school. The sad note is that Maria's husband, who is also disabled, left her because of the many pressing needs of the family. Maria has become the soul support for her 3 children. Two of the children are at Omega School and the firstborn is now in secondary school helped by Maria's sisters.

Maria says that she had bought a cow with the aim to save money to buy land, but the family member that cared for the cow sold it and kept the proceeds. She shares her story with tears running down her face with the hope of showing why this house was such an answered prayer and a beautiful surprise gift to her.

REACH did not tell her about the construction. She was invited to attend the prayer dedication of a house branded as Pastor Fred's house.
