Uganda was called the "Pearl of Africa" by the British because it is beautiful but it also has three growing seasons. The seasonal growing is very dependant upon rainfall. Crops might get a good amount of rain, but it can still be affected if the rains start late or end early. The last season which ended in December did not get consistent rainfall so this was a struggling crop. March was the start of the new season. Please pray for not just enough but consistent rainfall, and for a good harvest. This helps to provide the porridge meal all children receive daily.
