The family named this cow 'Kirabo', which literally means a special 'Gift'. They anticipated a calf, milk, and a daily income from it and now here they are. We seek more prayers that Kirabo will produce continually through God's provision.

This family has seven sons and two daughters. Please continue praying for a completed Secondary School by February, 2021. This is a huge prayer, but we have a big God. If this is successful, the children will stay at Omega School from Nursery to (HS) Graduation. First we need to finish the 6 classroom block building that requires a concrete floor, shutters, plaster, etc at a cost of \$15,000. The 4-story building needs \$6000 for the slab and \$17,500 for the ground floor. It will require \$9000 for water toilets. Desks must also be constructed.
