In the beginning of this term, we administered a set of exams to candidates in grade 7 (Primary seven). For all children who did not report for term two due to Covid 19 restrictions, those children received food donations in their respective homes.

Today December 22, 2020, all our children at Omega School have received their Christmas gifts, new clothing, cookies, a bottle of soda, and a bag of Maize Flour (food). They then marched home extremely happy and ready for their Christmas festivals.

We tried as much as possible to observe the "Standard Operational Procedures" given by the *Ministry of Health*. Some of the children, since we have large numbers, could not fit in the main hall, they sat on the veranda and they received all services perfectly. We will keep praying for you and it is our humble request that you keep praying for us too.
