On October 28, 2021, the president of Uganda made a national address about the opening of schools and the economy. His request was that 12 million people be vaccinated by December 2021 so that he can open the country fully. He however stressed that even if the goal of vaccinating 12 million is not reached by December, he will fully open the schools and the economy in January 2022. With vaccination, the focus will be on priority groups including health workers, teachers, and workers in bars and markets places. At Omega school we are looking forward to the day the school will be fully opened and see our children back. We would like however to be able to work constructions and improvements on structures before opening in January 2022. With Secondary school, contractions are to resume fully in December 2021. We however need more funding as the project is big and requires many \$1000's more. By January we shall give a full update after we resume with the building work.
