Every child deserves a chance to dream. This month, we celebrate Nicholas Tumwebaze, whose story shows what happens when sponsorship meets determination. Nicholas was born in a family of four boys and two sisters. He was six years old when he joined Omega school in first grade/primary one and after that REACH got him a sponsor through its sponsorship program, he later completed seventh grade.

In 2015, Nicholas took the chance seriously and never missed a term. Four years later, he sat for his form four examinations and passed well. Following his passion for working with people, Nicholas enrolled in a certified driving school. For six months he trained in road safety, basic vehicle maintenance, and passenger handling. He practiced on dusty back roads during evenings and passed his test on the first try.

Today at 23 years, Nicholas is a fully qualified driver. He runs a school pickup truck. His salary helps him to meet his needs and also pays school dues for his young cousin.

Am glad to report that first term has gone very well and the students have been doing end-of-term exams (see below), completing them last week.
